

Mormon Lake Road: 2019 Construction Project



Coconino County is partnering with the Federal Highway Administration Central Federal Lands Division (CFL) and the United States Forest Service (USFS) to widen and repave the entire length of Mormon Lake Road. This 9.8 mile project will extend from the north entrance to the south entrance, including its passage through Mormon Lake Village. The purpose of this project is to improve pavement conditions for vehicles and to provide wider paved shoulders for bicyclists and other multimodal users. These upgrades will improve access and safety for all roadway users.

The project is scheduled to begin construction in the spring of 2019 and will continue through the fall. Coconino County, CFL and the USFS will work to minimize impacts to residents and visitors, but construction activities will likely cause delays and may affect various annual events.

The purpose of this meeting is to provide an update to residents about this important project, including right-of-way, temporary construction easements and planned improvements near Mormon Lake Lodge. We hope you can attend.
