A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF COCONINO COUNTY, ARIZONA, FOR APPROVAL OF FISCAL YEAR 2022 PROBATION SUCCESS INCENTIVE REVENUE FOR STATE FUNDED PROGRAMS

Arizona Supreme Court, Administrative Office of the Court
FY 2022 Probation Success Incentive Grant

Whereas, A.R.S. § 12-270 directs a board that includes the chief probation officer from each county, in consultation with the Administrative Office of the Courts, to determine the distribution of statewide probation success incentive grant monies for each county for the most recently completed fiscal year; and

Whereas, this calculation is directly tied to the number of probationers successfully prevented from entering prison during the most recently completed fiscal year, compared to the county-specific historical baseline data on probation failures; and

Whereas, the Administrative Office of the Courts has authorized a Probation Success Incentive grant to Coconino County in FY 2022 of \$16,157; and

Whereas, this final disbursement was received on June 29, 2022, not allowing time for consideration of approval by the Coconino County Board of Supervisors prior to FY 2022 fiscal year end; and

Whereas, the Probation Success Incentive funds are non-reverting; and

Whereas, this funding supports programs that are grounded in evidence-based practices that have been proven to reduce recidivism and promote public safety.


THEREFORE, the Coconino County Board of Supervisors approves the FY 2022 grant from the Probation Success Incentive Fund consistent with each enhancement provided above.
