



RESOLUTION NO. 2023-20

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF COCONINO COUNTY, ARIZONA, TO APPOINT GEORGE ANSBACH AND CRAIG VOGEL TO THE JUNIPINE ESTATES FIRE DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS, EACH FOR A TERM TO EXPIRE ON DECEMBER 31, 2026.

WHEREAS, no candidates filed for a Junipine Estates Fire District Board position for the 2022 election, leaving a vacancy on the board; and,

WHEREAS, A.R.S. § 48-803 (B) provides “if a vacancy occurs on the district board other than from expiration of a term, a quorum of the board members shall fill the vacancy by appointment of an interim member”; and,

WHEREAS, a quorum of the remaining district board members did not fill the vacancy within ninety days of the vacancy as required by statute; and,

WHEREAS, A.R.S. § 48-803 (B) further provides that “if the quorum of district board members do not appoint an interim member within that ninety-day period, the board of supervisors shall appoint an interim member to the district board within sixty days after expiration of the ninety-day period”;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that The Coconino County Board of Supervisors find there are vacancies on the Junipine Estates Fire District Board created from a lack of candidates during the 2022 election; and

Finds that the Junipine Estates Fire District Board did not appoint interim members to fill the vacancies, and

Appoints to the Junipine Estate Fire District Board George Ansbach and Craig Vogel, each for a term that expires on December 31, 2026.


