RECOMMENDED MOTION:

Approve appointment of Andrew Hettinger as Judge Pro Tempore for the Page Justice Court, effective August 5, 2021 through June 30, 2022.

BACKGROUND:

Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order 2021-128 ordered that the administrative control and oversight of day-to-day operations of the Page Justice Court shall be assumed by the Honorable Dan Slayton, Presiding Judge of the Superior Court in Coconino County. The Supreme Court ordered the Presiding Judge, Dan Slayton to assign judicial officers as needed to conduct court business. Judge Slayton has ordered that Andrew Hettinger, who is currently serving as the Page Magistrate Judge, is appointed as a Justice of the Peace Pro Tempore effective August 5, 2021 to June 30, 2022. He has previously served as a Justice of the Peace in Maricopa County.

ALTERNATIVES:

To appoint another person to assume the judicial duties of the Page Justice Court.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The County will compensate Andrew Hettinger at the same rate of pay as the Page Justice of the Peace.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

WHEREAS, Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order 2021-128 ordered that the administrative control and oversight of day-to-day operations of the Page Justice Court shall be assumed by the Honorable Dan Slayton, Presiding Judge of the Superior Court in Coconino County,

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court ordered the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court in Coconino County to assign judicial officers as needed to conduct court business.

IT IS ORDERED that Andrew Hettinger, is appointed as a Justice of the Peace Pro Tem effective August 5, 2021 and he shall be compensated at the same rate of pay as the Page Justice of the Peace.

This appointment shall remain in effect until June 30, 2022.
