**A RESOLUTION OF THE COCONINO COUNTY, ARIZONA
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO ADOPT THE 2021 COCONINO COUNTY
MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN**

WHEREAS, Coconino County has experienced in the past, and will likely experience in the future, impacts from natural hazards such as wildland fire, drought, earthquake and seismic hazards, flood/flash flooding and post fire flooding/debris flows, pandemics and winter storms resulting in loss of life, property damage, economic hardship, and threats to public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 requires that a Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan be developed and adopted by communities wishing to obtain funding from FEMA mitigation grant programs; and

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona has a State Hazard Mitigation Plan, and the Coconino County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan supports the State Plan; and

WHEREAS, the 2021 Coconino County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan (MJHMP) has been developed through a process of review, research, and update work by Coconino County, the City of Flagstaff, the City of Page, the City of Williams, the Town of Tusayan, and the Town of Fredonia in coordination with the Arizona Department of Emergency and Military Affairs, and our vendor Constant Associates for the reduction of natural hazard risks to our county and communities; and

WHEREAS, the MJHMP specifically addresses hazard vulnerabilities, mitigation strategies and plan maintenance procedures for Coconino County; and

WHEREAS, the Coconino County Board of Supervisors met in Regular Session on September 28, 2021 and did, by this proclamation, adopt the 2021 Coconino County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), which provides financial assistance related to emergencies and mitigation projects, requires the County and all participating local jurisdictions to adopt the Hazard Mitigation Plan by Resolution in order to be eligible for federal mitigation funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, by the Coconino County Board of Supervisors that:

1. The MJHMP was adopted as an official plan of Coconino County on September 28, 2021.
2. In accordance with this this Resolution, the MJHMP shall be implemented, monitored, and maintained by the officials and staff designated in the MJHMP for a period of five (5) years from date of FEMA's formal plan approval on August 04, 2021.




