### **Discussion Topics**

- 1.) **Re-entry and Transitional Housing agreement between Catholic Charities, The Guidance Center and Coconino County-** Senior Programs Director Sandi Flores from Catholic Charities discussed the funding and partnership agreement that was recently supported by the County Board Of Supervisors.
- 2.) **Court Facilities Study Update-** Superior Court Administrator Sharon Yates introduced the consultants conducting the county court facilities needs assessment. One of the consultants Mr. Chang- Ming Teh explained in depth what the needs assessment would consist of and the length of time it would take to conduct the entire study. He indicated the assessment would be a 120-day project.
- 3.) **The MADD Victim Impact Panel-** Program Manager Carrie Robbins presented and explained the new victim impact panel that could now be completed online throughout the state. Carrie also mentioned that there is no limit/cap on the amount of people who could participate online.
- 4.) **Human Trafficking Awareness-** Director Of Human Trafficking Services Kate Wyatt from Northland Family Help Center discussed what services are available for victims of human trafficking, and what signs to look for with suspected human trafficking. Kate also discussed where safe zones are, and the partners such as Catholic Charities and local law enforcement who help to combat this issue daily.
