### **Discussion Topics:**

- 1.) Courts Executive Order Update-** Sharon Yates, Court Administrator for the Superior Courts, discussed the current phase the courts are currently in (phase 1) during the covid pandemic and also the current safety protocols the courts are practicing to continue to conduct business and provide services to the public.
- 2.) ROP Offenders, Alternatives now and long term-** Larry Henry, CJCC Coordinator led the discussion on the current low-level repeat offenders. Dan Musselman, Deputy Chief of the Flagstaff Police Department mentioned arrests are steadily increasing with this population and the department is trying its best to divert to alternative programming as much as possible. Brent Harris, City Prosecutor discussed the same issue, stressing that more alternative programming is needed, especially considering programming within the jail is currently suspended due to the covid pandemic. A major piece to the programming puzzle is housing. Several of our housing partners from the community such as Flagstaff Shelter Services, NARBHA, and Catholic Charities were in attendance and participated in the discussion. Finally, Amy Bacon from Arizona Health Choice provided statistics on what percentage of the ROP population are accessing programming services and the total costs of those services.
- 3.) Member Update Roundtable-** Bill Ring, County Attorney discussed the status of the legislative bills for diversion programming that were being introduced to State Legislators prior to the covid pandemic. With funding being shifted those bills were tabled. Bill intends to re-introduce those bills at the state County Attorney meetings in the coming weeks. Trevor Davis, Clinical Supervisor at The

Guidance Center discussed the current service protocols being provided to the public. Vice-Mayor Adam Shimoni discussed his involvement with the indigenous populations and better serving/providing services based on needs.
