

Host Your Special Event At The Historic Fort Tuthill Quad

The historic Fort Tuthill Quad is located at Fort Tuthill County Park, three miles south of Flagstaff. Coconino County Parks & Recreation renovated the site in 2017, upgrading the surface, water, electricity, and communications, making it ideal for weddings, corporate retreats, dog shows, art festivals, and more! The Quad is available for rent May 1 – September 30. Features include:

- Concrete pathways and decomposed granite sections
- Three (3) main entrances
- Electrical: (see map on back for details)
 - o Six (6) points of connection to 200 amps of 120/208 power
 - Six (6) portable electrical distribution panels (additional fee) each with eight (8) 50-amp RV services and six (6) 20-amp circuits
 - Multiple 50-amp connection points throughout the Quad
- Water: Gray water capabilities and water services
- Multi-zone public announcement PA system
- Landscaping with over 30 trees
- Four (4) drinking fountains, one (1) for pets
- Seven (7) built-in concrete benches
- Dark-sky compliant lighting
- Tie-downs for tents in select area
- Quad is completely fenced in
- Buildings available for rent (additional fee)
