

Checklist for Free-Standing Child Care Centers – March 20, 2020

To prevent the spread of COVID-19, Coconino County Health and Human Services (CCHHS) recommends the following guidance for free-standing child care centers:

- Prohibit any person except the following from accessing an operation:
 - Operation staff
 - Persons with legal authority to enter including law enforcement officers,
 - Child care licensing staff
 - Department of Child Safety staff
 - Professionals providing services to children
 - Children enrolled at the operation
 - Parents or legal guardians who have children enrolled and present at the operation.
- Require pick-up and drop-off of children outside of the operation, unless it is determined that there is a legitimate need for the parent to enter an operation.
- Before allowing entry into the operation, screen all individuals listed above including taking the temperature of each person upon arrival at the operation each day, and deny entry to any person who meets any of the following criteria:
 - A temperature of 100.4°F or above, OR
 - Signs or symptoms of a respiratory infection, such as:
 - low-grade fever
 - cough
 - shortness of breath
 - sore throat, OR
 - In the previous 14 days
 - has had contact with someone with a confirmed diagnosis of COVID-19, or
 - is under investigation for COVID-19, or
 - is ill with a respiratory illness; OR
- Prohibit any person who in the previous 14 days has traveled internationally to countries with widespread, sustained community transmission.
