Coconino County has moved into the **MODERATE** category.

- ❖ As of March 25th, 2021, Governor Doug Ducey issued [Executive Order 2021-06](#) which rescinded previous executive orders that restricted businesses.

RECENT CHANGES

▪ PER EXECUTIVE ORDER 2021-06:

- Business can resume regular operations.
- Businesses are encouraged to continue to take actions recommended by the CDC, U.S. Department of Labor, Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) and ADHS to limit and mitigate the spread of COVID-19. ADHS shall update its guidance accordingly. These entities still maintain the right to institute and enforce policies to mitigate against COVID-19 spread including the use of face coverings and physical distancing, and retain the right to refuse service to those who do not comply with the policies.



- Businesses have the option to continue to require face masks.

THIS PERMITS:

▪ **All BARS ARE OPEN**

- No dine-in service required.

▪ **BUFFETS, CAFETERIA OR SELF-SERVE SERVICE**

- Re-opened

▪ **ORGANIZED PUBLIC EVENTS**

- Groups of > 50 no longer must be approved by local jurisdiction.
- Recommended to follow CDC recommendations for slowing the spread of COVID-19.
 - Social distancing
 - Face covering
 - Handwashing or sanitizing options

- ❖ Businesses are **encouraged** to continue implementing adequate safety precautions to limit and mitigate the spread of Covid-19.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- **FUSD SCHOOLS**
 - Began their phase in-person learning as of March 22nd, 2021
- **COVID-19 VACCINE**
 - Any person aged 18 or older is eligible for the COVID-19 vaccine in Coconino County.
