Contact the agency you received the <i>BinaxNOW COVID-19 Antigen Self-Test At Home Kit</i> from and tell them “I have a positive result” and whom you performed this test on.</li> <li>2. Self-isolate and seek follow-up care with your healthcare provider if needed.</li> <li>3. CCHHS recommends seeking follow-up provider administered or saliva testing at a COVID-19 testing site or with your healthcare provider.</li> </ol>	<p>If you are sick: Stay home. Self-Isolate. CCHHS recommends seeking follow-up provider administered or saliva testing at a COVID-19 testing site or with your healthcare provider.</p> <p>Negative results should be treated as presumptive and do not rule out COVID-19 infection. Follow quarantine guidance.</p>

You must report positive results to the school, work, or community organization where you received the test as Coconino County Health and Human Services (CCHHS) cannot directly share your private medical information with these organizations on your behalf.

CCHHS will receive notice of your positive result from these agencies directly. You do not need to call CCHHS unless you have additional questions about COVID-19 and where to receive confirmatory testing. If you receive confirmatory testing and have a positive result, CCHHS will be in touch with you to provide information regarding the next steps.
