Our goal for these corridor meetings is to begin sharing of information regarding each specific flood corridor so that property owners in each corridor have a better understanding of the opportunities and challenges for long-term flood mitigation.

The District and its engineering consultants are continuing to prepare conceptual plans for long-term flood mitigation. Long-term flood mitigation involves three key, interdependent elements:

1. On-forest watershed restoration measures to restore alluvial fans and provide erosion control
2. Flood mitigation within the neighborhoods
3. Increasing drainage infrastructure capacity at Highway 89

This meeting is specific to only the Government Tank flood corridor so only information relative to this area will be discussed.
